## CBId.AdminControl Add-On Installation Guide.

## 1. Registration and starting of the Remote Snapshot Service for CBId.

- 1.1. Open *Config.ini* configuration file for editing, which is in the *Service* folder. Assign the full path to CBId program as a value for the *CBIdPath* string parameter. Note that CBId may be contained in the folder of the remote host. In this case the path value should start with \\<computername> or \\<IP Address> prefix..
- 1.2. Copy Service folder to the target remote host.
- 1.3. To register *RSSCBId* service in Windows Service Manager lunch RSSCBId.exe service application with */install* parameter.
- 1.4. To start RSSCBId service execute sc start rsscbid command in the command line.

Remark: There is an install.bat file in the Service folder. This batch file automates installation of RSSCBId service. Lunch this file if you have any hardship while installing RSSCBId service. In this case pass item 1.3 and 1.4.

## 2. Uninstalling of the Remote Snapshot Service for CBId.

2.1. In the command line type the following sequence of commands:

sc stop rsscbid

sc delete rsscbid

2.2. Delete the Service folder if you don't need RSSCBId at all.

## 3. Using of CBId.AdminControl add-on

- 3.1. Open *Config.ini* configuration file for editing which can be found in the same folder where AdmCtrl.exe is. Assign the full path to CBId program as a value for the *CBIdPath* parameter. It is recommended to have a copy of CBId program on the local machine.
- 3.2. Lunch AdmCtrl.exe file. At first, push *Analyze* button to find all computers in the local network. If you going to get snapshots via Internet then you should add a Group and then an IP Address of the remote host to be connected. Select the remote computer in the host list and push *Connect* button.
