NEW FEATURES

Following are the new features for the SonicWALL Global VPN Client 2.2.0.131:

- **Global VPN Client prompts user if the number of days remaining is less than 10 before the Domain password expires.** The remote user can then change the Domain password from the change password dialog by pressing Ctrl+Alt+Del.

RESOLVED ISSUES

Following issues have been resolved in the SonicWALL Global VPN Client 2.2.0.131:

- DNS and WINS were not resolved correctly when using the PPP adapter. Before routes were added for the SonicWALL Virtual Adapter, Windows would try to resolve names using the default route on the PPP adapter, which would fail.
- The interface table status was reported incorrectly; hence the connection could not be enabled on Windows XP systems prior to SP1.
- The login script was not executed in certain cases where the logon server was resolved incorrectly. Additional logs were added to display logon server and user name.
- Enabling a connection using Dial-Up Adapter on Windows XP systems after a reboot would result in the following error message: "The connection was terminated by the remote computer." On subsequent retry, the Dial-Up adapter would work correctly.
- If a dial-up connection is established and then the Global VPN Client connection is enabled, the user will be prompted to select the Phone Book entry again.
